PROGRAMS OFFERED



Equipment Rental and Filter Fabric:

- 7 foot Haybuster No-Till Drill
 - Rent for \$6.00/acre, \$60 minimum
- Hydraulic Post Driver
 - Rent for \$200/day
- Filter Fabric
 - 15 ft. wide, cut to length
 - \$2.50 per foot



Local Cost Share: 50% reimbursement NOT to exceed \$1,000 per operation

- **Lime:**
 - Documents needed:
 - Soil test (within the last 3 years)
 - Receipt of lime purchase
 - Updated Ag Water Quality Plan
 - Farm Map (mark where lime was spread)
- **Cover Crop:**
 - Documents needed:
 - Soil test (within the last 3 years)
 - Receipt of seed purchase
 - Updated Ag Water Quality Plan
 - Farm Map (mark where seed was spread)
- **Livestock Water Program:**
 - Program payment eligible for installation of permanent water line and frost proof tank. Dual check valve required when using municipal water source, pressure reducer may be required.
- **Livestock Exclusion Fence Program:**
 - Payment eligible for newly installed permanent fence to exclude livestock from woodland, sinkhole, or surface water (pond, lake, stream). Installed fence must protect, restore, or enhance an environmentally sensitive area. Property boundary fence not eligible. The plan, design, and construction this practice to comply with all federal, state, and local regulations.
- **Heavy Use Area Program:**
 - Payment eligible for installation of HUA for livestock feeding, livestock watering, gate openings, or equipment crossings. Any HUA for livestock feeding shall not be located within 150ft from blueline/intermittent stream, impounded body of water, or open throat sinkhole. Non-woven geotextile is required beneath the coarse aggregate base. Ag lime or class I sand can be used as surface material.



Additional program documentation may be requested by the Henry County Conservation District Board of Supervisors and the practice subject to a site visit.



Back Yard Conservation: Choose one project, all of these are a 50% reimbursement, NOT to exceed \$250 per household

- Rain Barrels
- Compost Bins
